# Geophysical studies at the NNSS (formerly NTS)

Presented by: Rob Mellors, Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory

#### **Abstract:**

The National Nevada Security Site (NNSS) (formerly the Nevada Test Site) covers a remarkable variety of geological features that includes volcanics, Paleozoic carbonates, exposed crystalline bedrock and alluvium. In this talk we present a brief overview of the geology and relevance to two recent studies. One study looks at the effects of the complex geology on seismic wave propagation as observed by a large array of seismometers and the other on the development of chimneys from underground nuclear explosions as inferred from surface observations and geophysics.
