Abstract: A new volume on the geology of Mount Diablo was published in late 2021 and titled: *Regional Geology of Mount Diablo, California: Its Tectonic Evolution on the North America Plate Boundary: Geological Society of America Memoir No. 217, 488 pages. Edited by Raymond Sullivan, Doris Sloan, Jeffrey Unruh, and David Schwartz.* The volume is a compilation of 17 new research papers, by 33 contributing authors, on the geology of Mount Diablo. This expansive color volume was assembled under the leadership of Ray Sullivan, Professor Emeritus of Geology at San Francisco State University. Its publication commemorates the 75th anniversary of the Northern California Geological Society (NCGS).
